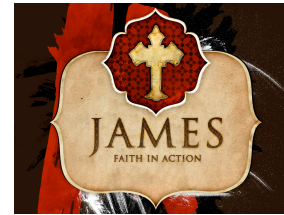
Connection Group Discussion Questions
